OFFICIAL COMMUNICATION

Since the 1st of July 2020, The OCBL Team as a private online-tournament organiser has decided to ask an independent group of people to give us advice on who should or shouldn't be invited to our events.

From that date onwards, the participation in all OCBL events may have been subject to the advice of CAT (Credential Advisory Team), our policy in order to avoid any possible conflict of interest and to maintain the impartiality of their advice has been to follow them in their integrity and to not ask the reasons behind.

OCBL is ready to take the first step to move on.

We will give a second chance to all the players who have been previously not been welcomed, if they publicly declare that he/she have violated the ethical conduct of bridge during online matches with the risk of influencing the results of the match/tournament.

The declaration will be considered public when made through one of the following channels: OCBL/ALT bulletin or www.bridgewinners.com.

Should the player once more violate the ethical conduct of bridge (including the online bridge), the player will not be allowed back ever again.

OCBL will revoke the non-invitation decision, effective the next tournament after the statement has been made by that player.

We strongly believe in second chances and we encourage others to follow this example.
